

Dial Up Connection in Windows Vista- ITCDial.co.uk

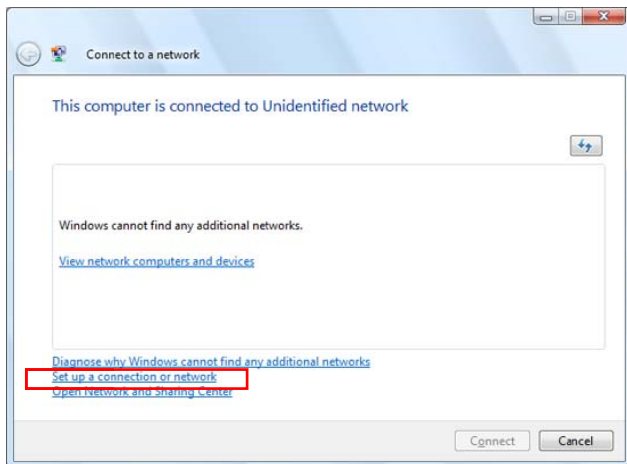
The following steps explain how to create a dial up Internet connection for a low speed modem in Windows Vista.

Note: Your modem must be installed correctly and connected to your computer and a telephone outlet.

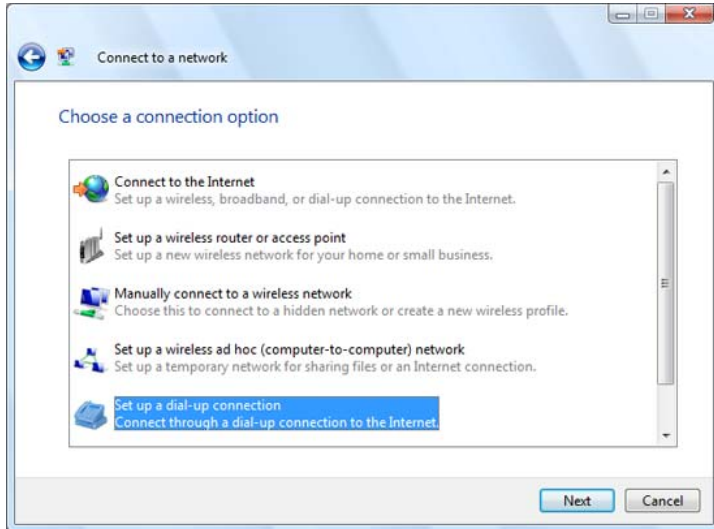
1. Click on the **Start** menu (blue button at bottom left hand side of the screen) and select **Connect To**.



2. This will open the **Connect to a network** wizard. Click on the **Set up a connection or network** link located to the bottom of the window.



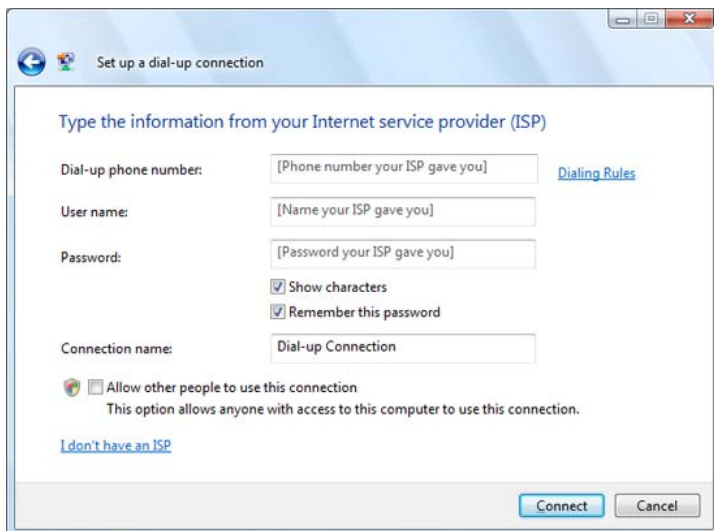
3. On the next page, select **Set up a dial up connection**, then click **Next**.



4. On the next page, enter the following information:

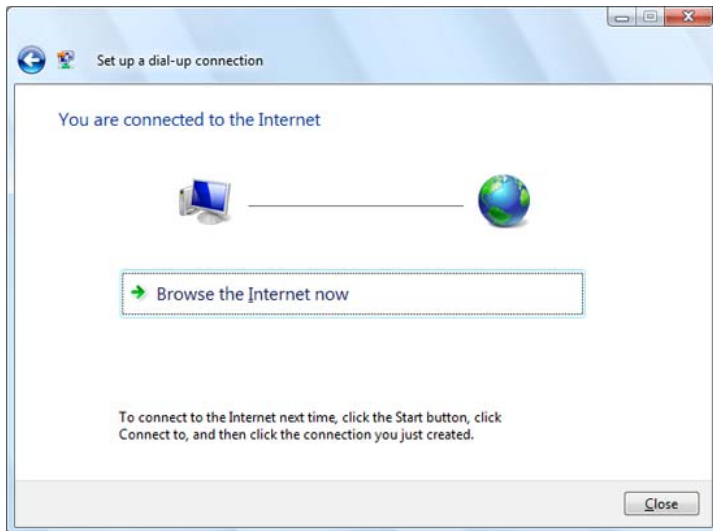
Dial-up phone number:	0845 029 1116
User name:	itcdial
Password:	free
Connection name:	Enter a connection name such as "ITC Dial"

ITC recommend ticking **Remember this password** box so you do not need to enter it again in the future. Once all the information has been entered, click **Connect**.

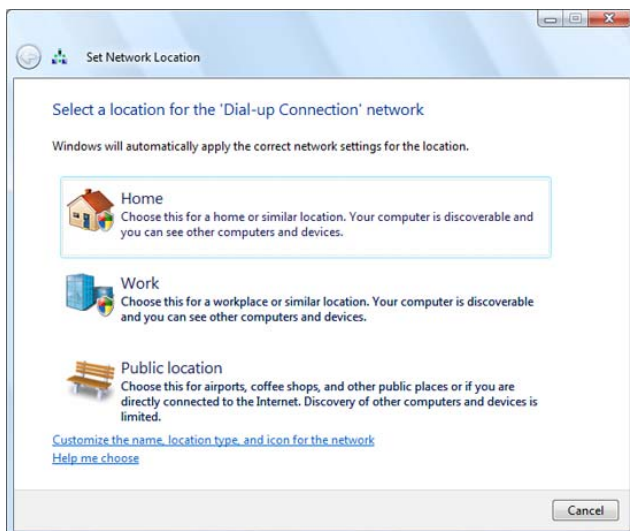


5. A new window will open stating it is dialing the connection.

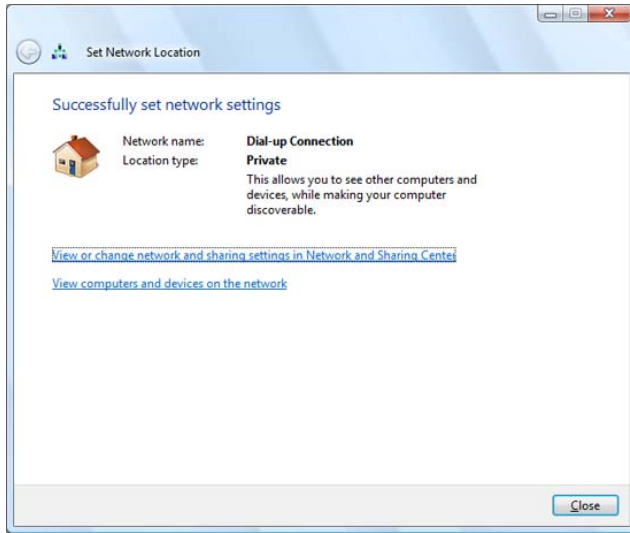
6. Once this is complete, you'll receive a message stating "You are connected to the Internet". If you click on **Browse the Internet Now**, your Internet browser will open.



7. When you click close, a new window will appear asking you to "Set Network Location". Select the applicable location and accept any User Account Control prompts that may appear.



8. You're done! The "Successfully set network settings" should appear, allowing you to close the wizard.
