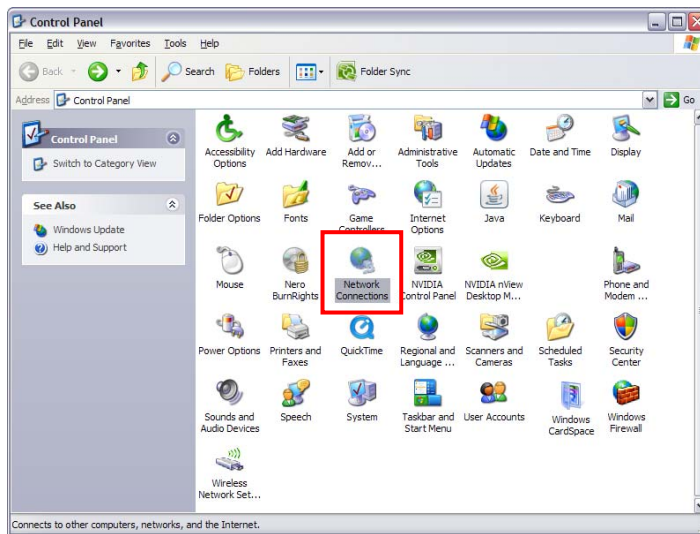


Dial Up Connection in Windows XP- ITCDial.co.uk

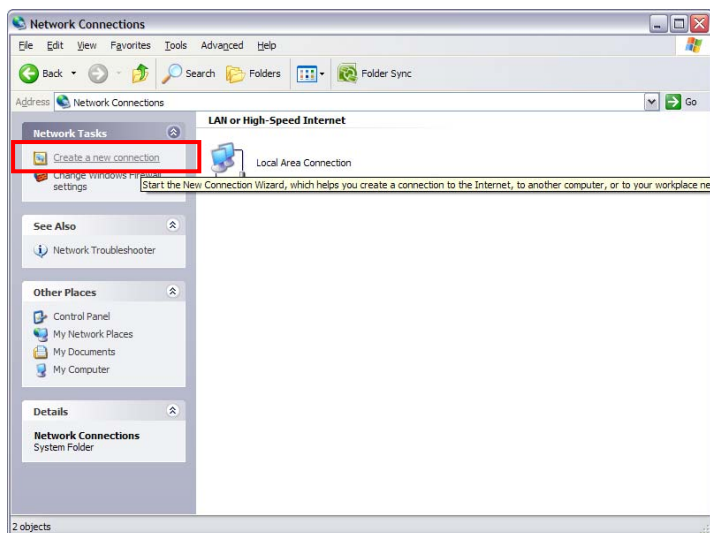
The following steps explain how to create a dial up Internet connection for a low speed modem in Windows XP.

Note: Your modem must be installed correctly and connected to your computer and a telephone outlet.

1. Begin by clicking on the **Start** button, then selecting **Control Panel**.
2. Once the **Control Panel** window is open, select **Network Connections**. If your computer doesn't look like the screenshot below, click **Network and Internet Connections** then **Network Connections**.



3. Once the new window opens, click the link on the left hand side that says "Create a new connection". This will start the **New Connection Wizard**.



4. With the wizard open, click **Next** and select **Connect to the Internet**. On the next page, select **Set up my connection manually** and then **Connect using a dial-up modem**.
5. Enter a name for your connection on the following screen and then click **Next**.

6. You'll then need to enter the telephone number (**0845 029 1116**) and then click next. If you everyone on your computer to be able to use this connection, select **Anyone's use**.
7. On the next screen enter **itcdial** as the username and **free** as the password:
